About BC's Low Carbon Fuel Standard

- BC's low-carbon fuel standard (LCFS) regulates companies that supply transportation fuel in BC by setting an allowable carbon intensity (CI) for each fuel type.
- Fuel suppliers that produce fuels **below the allowable limit generate compliance units (CUs)**. Companies with CUs can sell them to those with debits on the Credit Market, **creating a financial incentive for the production of low-carbon fuels.**
- **If you own EV chargers and pay for the electricity, you are a low-carbon fuel supplier** and could be eligible to receive \$300 - \$1,000 per level 2 charger and \$1,000 - \$4,000 per level 3 charger annually

The Challenge



Unless a business supplies a large number of EV chargers, **it is challenging to generate sufficient CUs**. Low credit volumes are difficult to market, so individual businesses may struggle to find a buyer.

How Synergy can Help



Synergy is registered as a fuel supplier and an aggregator with the LCFS. This means we can collect charging information from many businesses and **aggregate it into a single submission.**



This allows us to generate larger credit volumes than an individual business could, which makes it easier to market the CUs. **We can submit for, generate, and then sell CUs on a business's behalf.**
